

Color Menu - Tutorial

1. In order to add a new **Color Menu** page to your app access its **Dashboard**. Go to **Edit Pages** menu then click the "+" (Add New Page) button.

From the list of the page types available select the **Color Menu** one and click the "NEXT" button.

Menu Page Types	
<input type="radio"/>	Button Menu a classic list of buttons, each can be linked to a separate page.
<input checked="" type="radio"/>	Color Menu a funky colorful web-based menu
<input type="radio"/>	Content Menu an open web-based menu with a title, image, short description and multiple target options
<input type="radio"/>	Grid Menu a menu with thumbnails and short description
<input type="radio"/>	Image Menu displays a table of images, each can be linked to a separate page
<input type="radio"/>	Large Button Menu a menu with thumbnails and short description
<input type="radio"/>	Magazine Menu a menu with a thumbnail, title and description
<input type="radio"/>	Menu displays a list of items with thumbnail images.
<input type="radio"/>	Sample Menu very lightweight and stylish
<input type="radio"/>	Side Bar Menu minimalistic menu with header and footer options
<input type="radio"/>	Slide Show Menu Items Slide Show Menu Items
<input type="radio"/>	Stripes Menu stylish menu with thumbnails, titles and semiopaque background
<input type="radio"/>	WebKit Menu a classic rounded corners list of menu items
<input type="radio"/>	WebKit Submenu a classic rounded corners list of menu items
