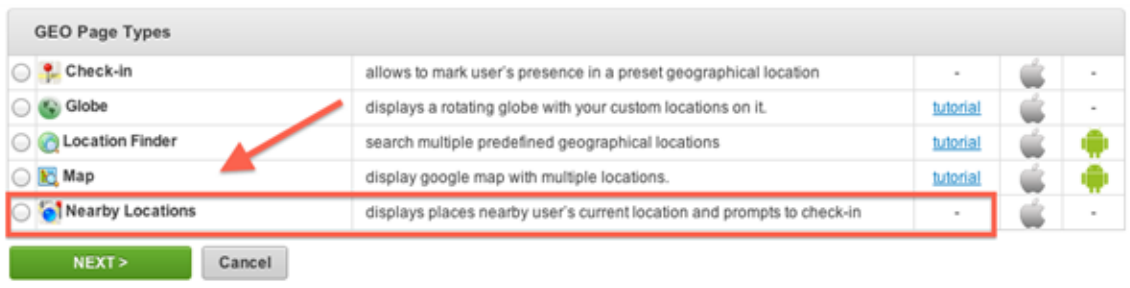


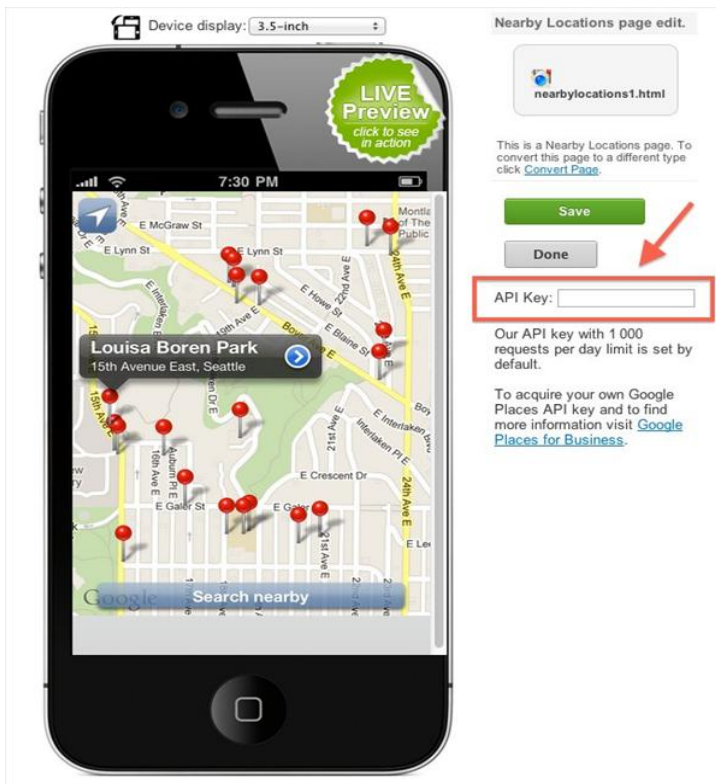
Nearby Locations Page Tutorial

Nearby Locations Page Tutorial

With this feature you may see the locations nearby. You may also see the locations near any point (coordinates) in the world. In order to add a new Nearby Locations page to your app, go to Edit Pages menu then click on the "+" (add a new page) button. From the list of the page types available, select Nearby Locations and click on the "Create" button.

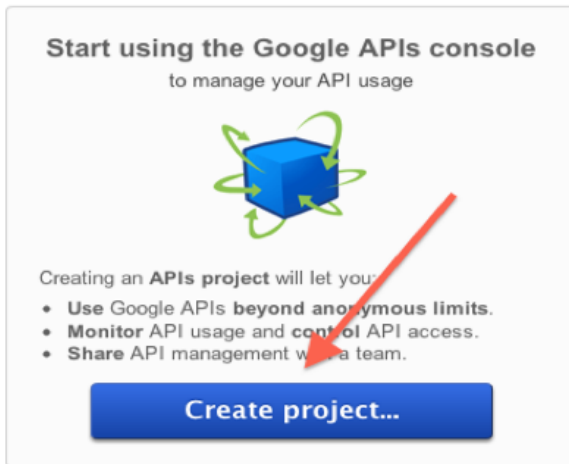


Once the page is added, you may proceed with editing it

After you press the "submit" button, go to the "API Access" page. Here you can see the API Key. Copy and paste it in the edit mode of the Nearby Locations page.

API Access
To prevent abuse, Google places limits on API requests. Using a valid OAuth token or API key allows you to exceed anonymous limits by connecting requests back to your project.

Authorized API Access

OAuth 2.0 allows users to share specific data with you (for example, contact lists) while keeping their usernames, passwords, and other information private. A single project may contain up to 20 client IDs. [Learn more](#)

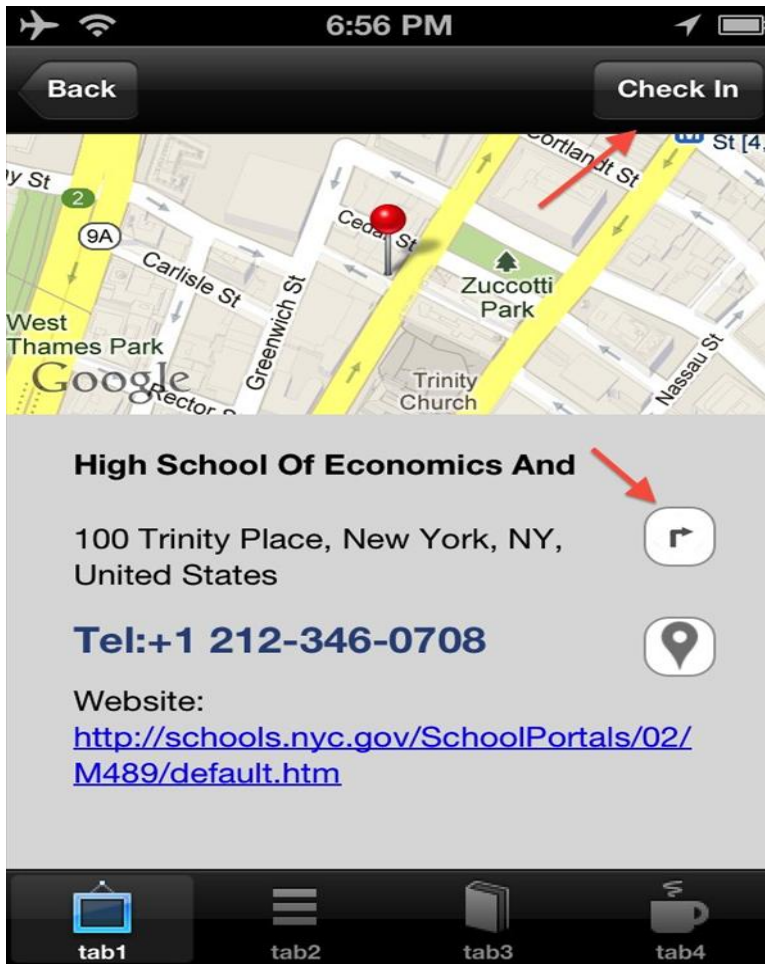

Once you are done with all the above steps, open the page in the AppsZero App Previewer on your iOS device.



1) Shows your current location
2) You may press on a location pin to see details. You may then Check-In with Facebook or use the Get Direction feature.



3) You can search for the locations nearby your place or any other place in the world. In order to search for locations near a different place than your current one, just move on the map and then press "Search nearby".

* Note that this page will show you all the locations: parks, museums, schools, buildings, restaurants, etc. It is not possible to search only specific locations.* The Nearby Locations page is available for Android and iOS platforms.
