

Rate & Review Page Type Tutorial

The Rate & Review Page Type is a great way to keep track of the experience the users of your application have.

In order to add a Rate and Review page type you need to access your Application's Dashboard and go to "Edit pages" section. Click on Add New Page button, the "+" button below the list of the currently available pages.

<input type="radio"/>	Radio Stream	This page allows users to stream live radio with the help of HTML5.	-	Apple	-
<input checked="" type="radio"/>	Rate and Review	This page displays the ratings and reviews other users have given to this application.	tutorial	Apple	Android

<input type="radio"/>	Shopping Cart	This page allows users to view and interact with a shopping cart.	tutorial	Apple	Android

1- Select the Rate & Review Page Type

2- Press Create

After these steps a new Rate & Review page will appear in your application dashboard. As this type of page can't be edited, you only need to link it within the application.

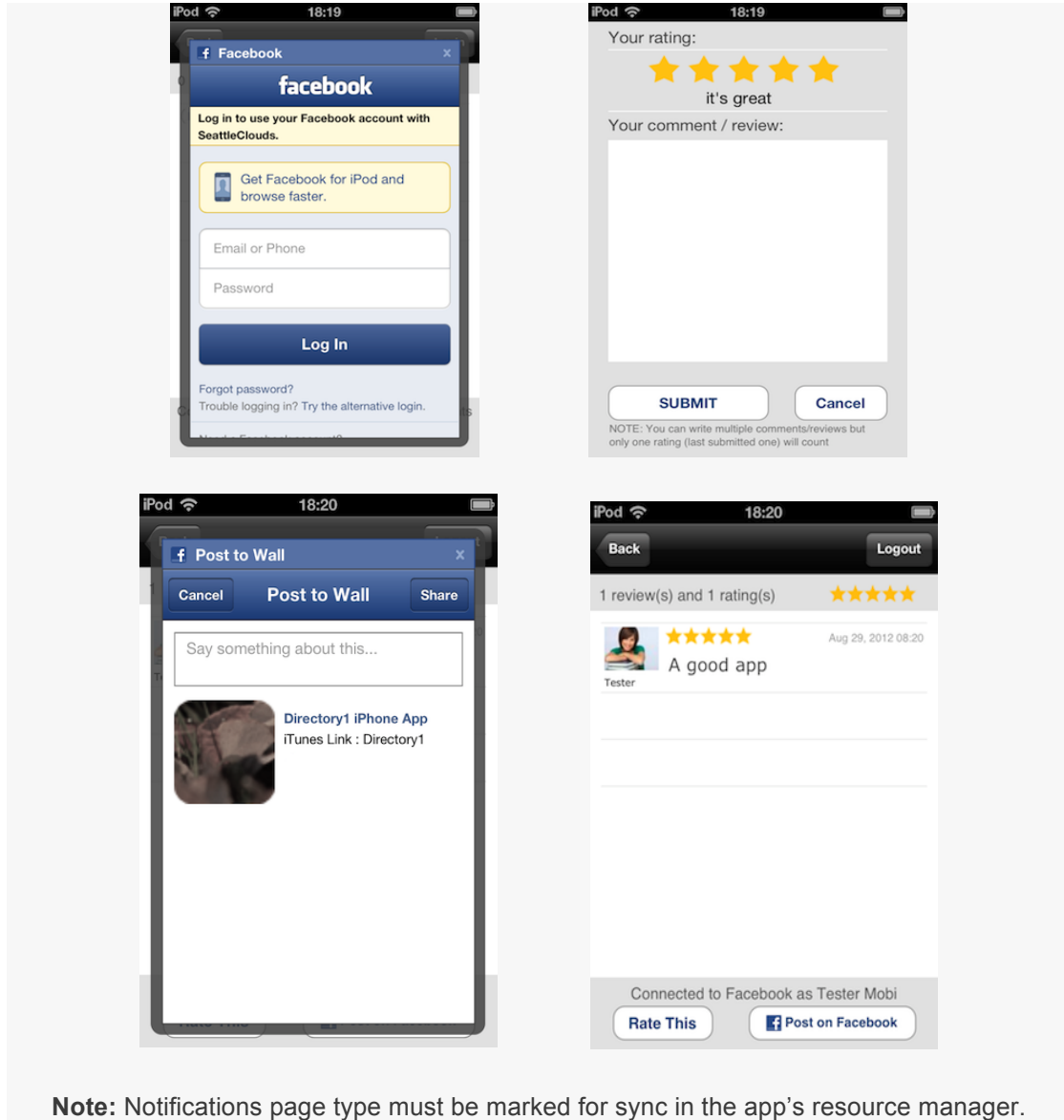
This can be accomplished by adding a Rate & Review Button linked to the Rate & Review Page Type.
